Christian greetings from the Rubaare Secondary School community. The school appreciates parents and guardians for paying fees and supporting their children through the term.

1. Closure of Term II 2026

Term II 2026 ended on Tuesday 18 August 2026 at 2:00 PM.

Students went home with a report card, fees bill and parent's letter. Parents and guardians are asked to study these documents carefully and advise their children accordingly.

2. Academics

- All S.1, S.2, S.3, S.4, S.5 and S.6 learners completed Beginning-of-Term-II examinations and curriculum Activities of Integration.
- S.1, S.2, S.3 and S.5 completed End-of-Term-II examinations.
- S.4 and S.6 completed District Mock examinations.
- Academic bursaries are still offered, and admissions remain available in S.1, S.2, S.3 and S.5.
- Workbooks for different subjects are available at school. Parents may contact the teachers concerned to purchase workbooks for their children.

The school held a thanksgiving for strong UCE and UACE performance on 11 August 2026. The Bishop of South Ankole Diocese, Rt. Rev. Bishop Nathan Ahimbisibwe, officiated at the ceremony.

3. Requirements

- S.1, S.2, S.3 and S.5 students who did not bring a ream of ROTATRIM paper should do so.
- S.4 and S.6 students should bring PICFARE ruled paper.
- No cash is allowed at school.
- Students should bring a 2.5-inch mattress that fits on the school beds.

- Visitors should come with a visitor's card when visiting the school.

The Annual General Meeting held on 1 November 2025 resolved that each student should pay UGX 25,000 for the school magazine and UGX 10,000 for the school calendar.

4. Academic Meetings

S.1 and S.2 Career's Day: Saturday 26 September 2026. Parents and guardians are requested to attend so the school and families can plan and advise learners together.

Visiting Day: Saturday 10 October 2026.

5. Co-curricular Activities

The boys' school football team participated in Ball Games II at District level, emerged third and qualified for the Ankole Zonal Games in Ibanda District. The girls participated up to District level.

6. Welfare

Meals consist mainly of posho and beans. Matooke is sometimes served when there is enough from the plantations. Greens from learners' projects are also used in meals.

7. Discipline

Overall discipline remains satisfactory. A small number of cases were noted, including dodging lessons, absenteeism, theft, escapism and destruction of school property.

Students with academic challenges are to collect their reports on Tuesday 25 August 2026 and should be accompanied by their parents for guidance and counselling.

8. School Development

- The school water project is complete.
- Junior Staff Quarters (JSQ I) are complete.
- The school has launched construction of a three-storeyed girls' dormitory to improve accommodation for girls.
- Rt. Rev. Bishop Nathan Ahimbisibwe launched the girls' dormitory project on 11 August 2026.
- The school requests support for the girls' dormitory project.
